Company Background

Carbon Clean Solutions Limited (CCSL) is an innovation leader in carbon dioxide (CO₂) separation technology for industrial and gas treating applications. Our step-change technology significantly reduces the costs and environmental impacts over existing CO₂ separation techniques. With >30 operating plants using CCSL's patented technology and one large scale carbon capture and utilisation plant operating in India.

The company has recently successfully raised an equity investment of \$16 million from three global investors, WAVE Equity Partners, Chevron Technology Ventures, and Marubeni Corporation.

The investment will be used to deliver an existing pipeline of global projects to lower emissions from industry. CCSL will also invest in the development of "containerized" solutions to achieve \$30/tonne cost of CO₂ capture by 2021.

Affordable CCS technology has a critical role to play in the transition to a low-carbon energy future. It is one of a host of technologies that will be required to tackle climate change. CCSL believes that renewables alone will not be enough if the world is to reach net-zero emissions targets whilst also meeting the energy needs of a fast-growing global population still largely reliant on fossil fuels.
